



How to dispose of non-burnable garbage

※Please use the designated bag for non-burnable garbage

Garbage that can be put out on the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and the 5th Fridays.

- Vinyl
- Plastics other than plastic containers and packaging



※Target : Items that can not be recycled

- *Items without the plastic mark
- *Items with the plastic mark but very dirty

【Classification Examples】

Plastic, Vinyl, Leather, Rubber hose, Videotape, CD, etc.



Garbage that can be put out on the 4th Friday.

- Metals (iron, aluminium, stainless steel, etc.)
- Fragile items

【Classification Example】

Home appliances, Ceramics, Umbrellas, Metals (iron, aluminium, stainless steel, etc.)

Collection locations for mobile batteries (small rechargeable batteries)

Targeted Batteries

- Used up batteries
(including swollen or deformed ones)
- The positive and negative terminals are insulated with tape
- Batteries with the following recycle mark and product name.



(Ni-Cd)



Nickel-metal hydride



Lithium-ion

※We also collect small rechargeable batteries made overseas or of unknown origin that do not have the above mark! If you are not sure how to dispose of them, insulate them and take them to a collection point.

Those batteries contain rare metals. By collecting and recycling them, they can be reused as valuable resources.
